- Written support and character reference from TWO referees (dated less than two years old).
- Details of academic achievements – ie a copy of school reports for year 9-10 students, a copy of academic NCEA transcript, or summary of that transcript for years 11-13 students. All tertiary students must provide latest academic transcript from relevant tertiary institute.
- A summary of other achievements in chosen field of the performing arts and any other relevant matters or achievements.
- An outline of how the applicant is currently funding tuition requirements.
- Confirmation of any other grants that have been applied for.
- An outline of current barriers that may exist to the applicant's tuition such as travel, financial, local or outside tutors.

Applications close at 5pm 31 March (round 1) and 30 September (round 2) each year.

Notes for applicants:

- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- Application must be in A4 format and single-sided with no staples.
- Do not include original documents, please give copies as originals may not be returned.
- Grants will not be paid directly to applicants but paid directly to teachers or service providers upon presentation of invoices.
- It is the committee's policy not to fund the purchase of capital items (instruments, hardware or equipment). This may only be awarded for applicants who illustrate exceptional talent and grades from internationally recognised qualifications.
- Preference will be given to students working towards a formal qualification, eg: grade 8 exams.
- Applicants may only apply once in any calendar year, for either our March OR September funding round. However, grants can be applied for year after year, and are not restricted to one grant allocation per person. If your project is ongoing we encourage you to apply each year you require funding.
- It is the committee's policy not to fund recordings or shows/concerts.
- Applicants must have resided in Taranaki for a minimum of two years prior to the date of application.
